Total results were 3 US KIA 7 US WIA 2 ARVN WIA, 4 North Vietnamese civilian WIA. At 0919 hrs vic 633298 D Co got two body count and 1 SKS. 2nd company 1/49 found a medical cache and two VC POWs at 0929 vic 644290. 4 SKS' were also found. 2nd/49 and P Co at 1034 vic 605324 found 4 VC in a tunnel and destroyed it.
